Cango Lyec Program Reducing HIV risk, Increasing access to treatment and promoting resilience among conflict-affected populations in Northern Uganda" herein referred to as 'Cango Lyec Study', is a collaboration between Child Health and development Centre (CHDC), Makerere University College of Health Sciences (MAK – CHS), the University of British Columbia (UBC), Canada, and Northern Uganda Program on Health Science (NUPHS), and covers the districts of Gulu, Amuru, Nwoya and Omoro.

The main objective is to develop, and test <u>Culturally-safe</u>, <u>Strengths-based</u>, <u>Trauma-informed</u>, <u>Technology-enhanced</u> (CSTT) interventions among war affected populations in Northern Uganda. The purpose is to improve access to and uptake of HIV, Hepatitis B, and trauma services in the war affected populations.

The program seeks to recruit a suitably qualified, committed and self-driven individual to fill the following position(s) of Psychiatric Nurse in the program.

Roles:

- Responsible for Identification and diagnosis of Psychiatric conditions among study participants.
- Facilitate referral of Psychiatric cases for better management.
- Conduct pre-test counseling and collect biological specimens.
- Responsible for accurate, complete and efficient administration of Consent, Census,
 Questionnaires and any other data collection tools.
- Participate in one-on-one participant health education and provision of basic health care to study participants.
- Perform any other responsibilities that may assigned from time-to-time by the Principal Investigator (PI).

Qualifications:

- Candidates to this position must possess at least a Diploma in Psychiatric Nursing.
- Should be able speak the local language (Acholi)
- Previous experience of working in research setting and knowledge of using ODK tool for data collection will be an added advantage.
