Personal Statement

I am currently a Professor of Medicine, Principal of Makerere University College of Health Sciences, immediate past Dean of the School of Medicine, and a researcher in Infection and Immunity at the Infectious Diseases Institute (IDI) and co-Director of the Makerere University – Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI) Centre of Excellence for Infection and Immunity Research and Training (MUII-plus). I am also the scientific director of the translational laboratory at the IDI. I have over 22 years' experience in HIV/AIDS care at different platforms including community trials with simple interventions such as safe water and cotrimoxazole prophylaxis to reduce morbidity and mortality among people living with HIV (PLHIV), hospital-based studies to evaluate the implementation of basic tools like provider-initiated HIV testing and routine TB screening to improve access to HIV diagnosis, management of TB-HIV co-infections and timely initiation of anti-retroviral therapy in a hospital setting, epidemiological studies to understand immune recovery in long-term HIV treatment cohorts, laboratory-based studies to understand cellular mechanisms of suboptimal immune recovery, as well as clinical trials on innovative interventions of adjuvant therapy to maximize the benefits of antiretroviral therapy among PLHIV. In addition, I have been involved in evaluation of health systems and national policy review processes to inform the formulation, revision and implementation of HIV/AIDS care policies.

I am currently involved in translational research to build local capacity to utilize basic science research to improve HIV treatment and prevention in sub-Saharan Africa. My research focus is to understand chronic HIV-associated inflammation during HIV treatment and its long-term complications of immune aging and non-AIDS illnesses. I am also involved on studies to utilise m-health platforms to digitalise patient follow up to promote social distancing during the COVID19 pandemic.

LEADERSHIP EXPERIENCE:

I have over seven years of leadership experience as deputy Dean, subsequently Dean of the School of Medicine (SOM) and currently Principal of Makerere University College of Health Sciences, that have enriched my leadership and management skills. I have led several collaborative research and training programs over the last 13 years, collaborating with academic and research institutions in Uganda, and overseas. As vice chair of the Uganda Cancer institute Research and Ethics committee for four years I led various initiatives to regulate research and protection of human subjects in cancer research. I have a passion to build the next generation of scientists that will combat current and future challenges to global health in Africa and worldwide.

STUDENT SUPERVISION AND MENTORSHIP:

I have supervised over 50 graduate scientists at masters, doctoral and post-doctoral levels, as well as faculty in various collaborative training programs including the Afya Bora Consortium for global health leadership training, the Makerere University -Uganda Virus Research Institute Infection and Immunity (MUII) capacity building program, the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Fogarty International Center (FIC) GloCal health fellowship, and the Nurture research training and mentoring program for career development of faculty at Makerere University College of Health Sciences, among others.
