APPLICATIONS INVITED FOR CLINICAL SUB-SPECIALTY TRAINING FELLOWSHIPS IN PAEDIATRIC HAEMATOLOGY AND ONCOLOGY AND PERINATAL AND NEONATAL MEDICINE (NEONATOLOGY)

The Registrar, School of Medicine, College of Health Sciences, Makerere University invites Paediatricians to apply for a 2-year Clinical Training Fellowship Programme in Paediatric Haematology and Oncology (PHO) and in Perinatal and Neonatal Medicine (PNM)/Neonatology at the College of Health Sciences, Makerere University commencing August 2025.

The fellowship training programmes are delivered in collaboration with the Ministry of Health, Mulago National Referral Hospital and Texas Children's Hospital/Baylor College of Medicine, USA(for PHO) and with the Ministry of Health, St. Francis Hospital Nsambya, Mulago Specialized Women and Neonatal Hospital, Kawempe National Referral Hospital, and Seed Global Health (for PNM/ Neonatology). Successful fellows will receive a formal Sub Specialty award in the respective fields, accredited by Uganda Medical and Dental Practitioners Council (UMDPC), of Makerere University College of Health Sciences.

Positions available:

1. Peadiatric Haematology and Oncology - 4 positions

Perinatal and Neonatal Medicine (Neonatology) - 4 positions

Eligibility: Masters of Medicine degree in Paediatrics and Child Health or equivalent; Registration and current License to Practice Medicine and Paediatrics.

Admitted fellows will receive a 2-year scholarship to cover tuition, living costs and educational materials, regardless of nationality. Currently, PNM/ Neonatology fellowship scholarship admissions are for only Ugandans.

Please note that shortlisted candidates will be invited for interviews at the School of Medicine College of Health Sciences, Makerere University Kampala prior to selection for admission.
